



Notice: In homes where small children may be present, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) recommends that steps be taken for certain furniture items to prevent or minimize the risk of tipover. This furniture is equipped with Tipover Restraint Hardware for use to minimize this risk, if used. Please follow the instructions printed on the hardware package for proper installation steps. Riverside Furniture Corp. recommends that parents and guardians stay up to date on all issues related to children's safety in the home.

Warning: This tipover restraint is not to be a substitute for proper adult supervision. Do not allow children to climb on furniture. Items left on top of the TV and furniture, such as toys, remote controls and treats might tempt young children to climb.


Important: Check to be sure the wall bracket is firmly screwed into wall stud, the furniture bracket is firmly attached to the furniture, and the strap is snug. Riverside Furniture Corp. assumes no liability for improper installation or excessive loads placed on screws, brackets or straps. Failure to detach this restraint before moving furniture may result in personal injury and property damage.





Notes:

- 1. To prevent possible scratches or damage, assemble on a soft surface such as a blanket or carpet.
- Assemble the Bottom Back Panel (H) between the Left and Right Side Panels ((I), using the 1 ¹/₂" Long Allen Head Bolts (A), Spring Washers (B), and Flat Washers (C). Do not fully tighten until after Step 4.
- 3. Assemble the Upper Back Panel ((G) on the top edge of the Bottom Back Panel and connect to the Side Panels as above.
- 4. Carefully place the Top Panel on top of the Back Panels and End Panels. Fasten in place using the 1 ½" Long Allen Head Bolts (A), Spring Washers (B), and Flat Washers (C) across the top edge of the Upper Back Panel and 1 ¼" Long Allen Head Bolts, Spring Washers and Flat Washers at the top of the Side Panels.
- 5. Tighten all bolts using the Allen Wrench (D).
- 6. After TV Console Deck is attached to Console Base, install Shelf Support (F) and install Shelf (K) into TV Console Deck.



Note:

To prevent possible scratches or damage, assemble the TV Console upside down on a soft surface such as a blanket or carpet.
Assemble two Front Legs (G) to the bottom of the TV Console using the 3/4" Allen Head Bolts (A), Spring washers (B), and Flat washers (C).

3. Assemble two Back Legs (H) and one Middle Leg (I) to the bottom of the TV Console using the 5/8" Allen head bolts (E), Spring washers (B), and Flat washers (C)

4. Tighten all Bolts using the supplied Allen wrench (D).

5. Carefully turn the TV Console upright.

6. Install the Wire Hoops (J) into the holes on the Pull-Out Media Shelves.

7. If required, the TV Console can be adjusted using the levelers screwed into the bottom of the legs to compensate for uneven floors.

8. If the TV Console is being used without the Deck, the Anti-Tipping Restraints should be connected to the back of the Console. Firmly attach the Restraint to a wall stud using the Wood Screws (L). Move the Console to near the wall and install the Anti-Tipping Restraint Strap.
